# **Centos Linux Printer Management**

These instructions are for the new Centos Linux systems.

at the 'dot' prompt:

#### prt

is a menu to easily execute each of the following commands

#### **Ipstat**

displays the status of ALL of your printers press [space] to page through, until you get back to the 'dot'

### lpstat <lpt#>

displays the status of a single printer notice the small case. example: lpstat lpt1

#### 1pstat -o

displays only print jobs that are queued.

### lprm <job\_number>

removes a print\_job from the queue. first, find the job\_number using the lpstat command example: 1prm 01234

## lprm -a <lpt#>

removes all print\_jobs that are queued to a specific printer. example: lprm -a lpt1

## lpmove <source> <destination>

moves all print jobs from one print queue to another.

example: 1pmove 1pt1 1pt2
